

## Updated list of medical needs for Haiti

(as of 22 Feb 10)

1. I.V. solutions, especially Normal Saline or Ringers Lactate, usually bags of 1000 ml. They can use some D5W, but NS and RL are needed more.
2. 50 or 100 ml bags, Normal Saline, for administration of I.V. meds
3. 10 cc syringes
4. 10 cc prefilled NS syringes
5. Needles - 20 gauge are ideal, but 22 and 18 can also be used
6. Kerlex dressings
7. 4X4 gauze for dressings
8. Ace wraps - 3, 4, and 6 inch
9. Heparin locks
10. Antibacterial hand cleanser
11. I.V. antibiotics, **especially Cefazolin (= Ancef, = Kefzol) and Gentamycin**
12. Lortabs, 5 and 7.5 mg

### **Dressing Supplies, etc.**

1. Band-aids
2. Alcohol
3. Alcohol swabs

5. Gauze – rolls and pads, all sizes
6. Ace bandages
7. Needles – all gauges
8. Syringes – all sizes
9. Casting tape – plaster and/or fiberglass
10. Sterile saline
11. Cold/hot packs
12. Tape – sterile and nonsterile, all sizes and materials
13. Unna boots
14. Sterile gloves
15. Stockinet – all sizes

### **Soft Goods**

1. Velcro splints – wrist
2. Fracture boots for ankle and foot fractures
3. Knee braces – hinged or not, with or without stays, etc.
4. Knee immobilizers
5. Crutches – all sizes
6. Slings
7. Walkers
8. Cervical collars
9. Finger splints
10. Shoulder immobilizers
